Put it into Practice

Find out about each other's families. Remember that the topic goes at the beginning and the question goes at the end of the sentence, and to lean forward and raise eyebrows for a question. For example:

- Brother, sister have? How-many? (How many brothers and sisters do you have?)
- Brother, sister name what? (What are your siblings names?)
- You grandmother name what? (What's your grandmother's name?)
- You grandfather, how-old? (How old is your grandfather?)
- You email address what? (What's your email address?)
- You birthday when? (When is your birthday?)
- You credit card number what? (JOKES!)
- You married you? (Are you married?)
- You Deaf you? (Are you Deaf?)
- You live where? (Where do you live?) You address what? (What's your address?)
- You live with who? (Who do you live with?)
- Nephews nieces have you? (Do you have any nephews or nieces?)
- Children have you? How many? (How many children do you have?)
- Father, he brother sister have he? (Does your father have any siblings?)
- Aunty name what? (What's your aunty's name?)
- Cousins have you? (Do you have any cousins?) Live where? (Where do your cousins live?)
